Coach's Code of Conduct

Being a participant in Tualatin Youth Basketball Association (TYBA) is a privilege, not a right. Associated with this privilege are responsibilities of personal conduct. Players, coaches, referees, visitors and family members are expected to show sportsmanship, fair play, and encouragement. One of TYBA's primary objectives is to teach, practice, and instill players the characteristics of good sportsmanship and TYBA expects our coaches to do the same. Please review the code of conduct found below, sign this form, and follow throughout the season. This form must be signed and returned before practices can commence.

- Coaches must know the official rules of the league and/or tournaments and be able to teach them to the players, as well as the parents.
- Coaches shall treat all players, officials, parents, and spectators with courtesy and respect.
- Public criticism of officials, coaches, and players is inappropriate and will not be tolerated.
- Coaches shall not use profane language at any time.
- Coaches are expected to maintain a positive and instructive attitude.
- Coaches should avoid physical contact with Players.
- If a second coach is unavailable, a parent must attend practice. It is mandatory to have two adults at all practices.
- Coaches should communicate with the parents and spectators, encouraging positive interaction during the games.
- Coaches shall NOT leave Players alone in any facility at the conclusion of practices and games.
- Coaches shall NOT instruct Players to arrive early to their assigned practice times.
- Coaches are responsible for the proper use of gym facilities and will respect the instructions of the Monitors who are hired by Tigard-Tualatin School District (TTSD).
- Coaches shall notify TYBA should they and their assistant coaches are unable to attend a practice/game.
- Only age appropriate Rec players may play in Rec games. No older or younger siblings, and no competitive players are allowed to participate.
- Water is the only liquid allowed in the gyms. No food, candy, or other drinks of any kind are allowed in the gym.

I have read and understand the above Coach's Code of Conduct and agree to adhere by these conditions as a coach for the TYBA. I understand that I serve as a volunteer at the discretion of the TYBA. I also understand that a violation of this code may result in my termination as a coach for TYBA.
