Rec Ball - Rules for the Draft

Tualatin Youth Basketball Association (TYBA) strives to create a fun experience for all our players, coaches, and families. In order to achieve this goal at the recreational level, balanced teams must be created. Below are the rules and guidelines to help keep it balanced.

- 1. The Draft is conducted in a serpentine pattern. The coach with the last pick of one round will have the first pick of the next round. For example: if there are 4 coaches in the order of A, B, C, and D Coach A will begin the first round and Coach D will end that round. When D has selected their player for round 1, they will start the selection for round 2 and we will proceed in reverse order: D, C, B, and A.
- 2. Players eligible to be selected in each round are as follows:
 - a. Round 1 and Round 2 are where "A" players are selected.
 - b. Round 3 and Round 4 are where "B" players are selected.
 - c. Round 5 and Round 6 are where "C" players are selected.
- 3. Coaches' and assistant coaches' kids are evaluated and rated by all coaches and placed on the draft board according to their ranking. The Coach with the lowest ranked player gets the first pick and the order continues based upon their ranked child. When the coach comes to the round where his son/daughter is placed, they will not draft that round.
- 4. Any discrepancies will be decided by the person running the draft.
- 5. Paperwork to be completed:
 - a. 2 TYBA team rosters (one for coach and one for TYBA)
 - b. Signed Code of Conduct form
 - c. Practice Time Request form
